- Th** Write an action sequence for something your own River Creature gets up to and submit it to your teachers.

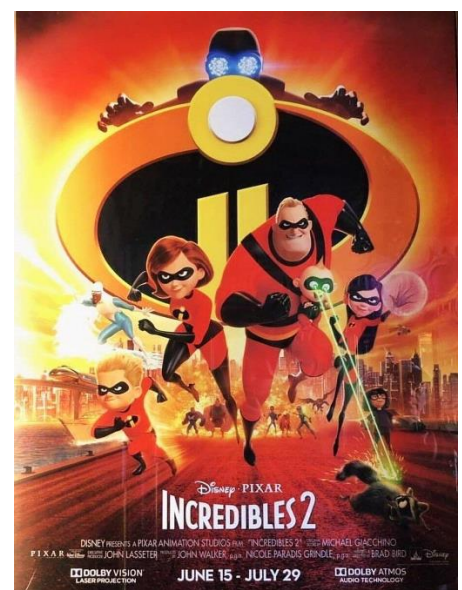
