



## Learning in Year 1

Year 1 have been learning about plants and pollination. The children wanted to create a bee friendly planter to encourage pollination so they chose some bright and colourful flowers with a lovely scent to attract the bees. This week they have been learning how to carefully remove the plants from the pots and then plant them well into the soil. The children know that plants need sunlight, food and water to grow, so they will be making a "plant watering" rota for the next month. They will also be keeping a look out for some busy bees!



## Learning in Year 2

Year 2 have been learning about capacity and volume. We've been learning how much a litre is. First, we learned how to read scales on our measuring jugs. We estimated how many of Mr Carey's running bottles, snack pots and coffee cups it would take to fill up a litre jug. Then we checked how

accurate our estimates were. Next, we went out onto the balcony to see how many litres would fit into our large

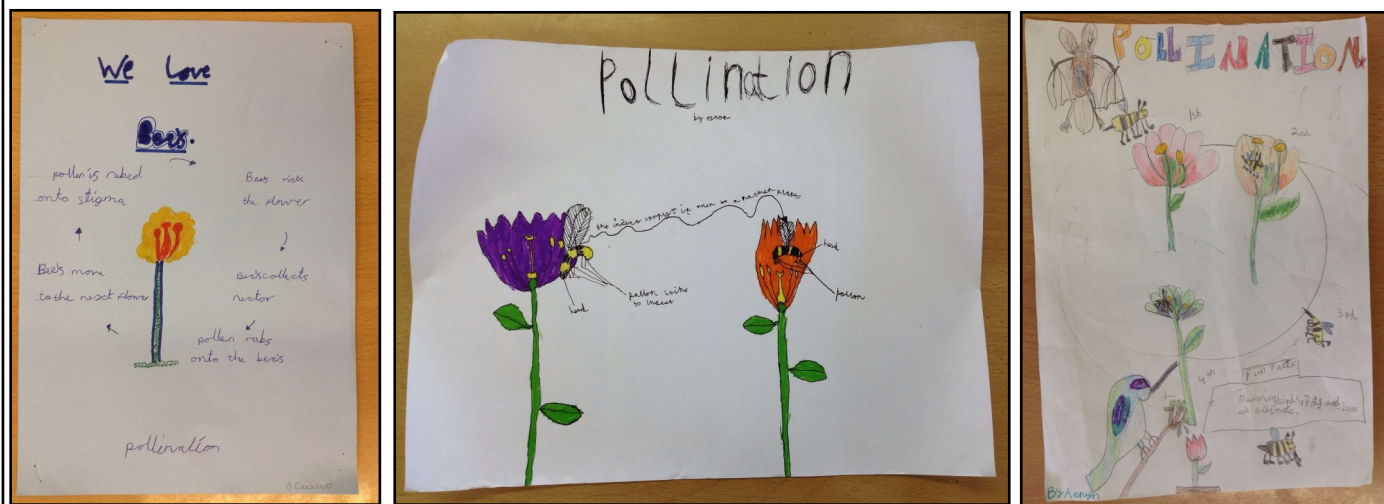
green trays. We were careful not to get too wet!





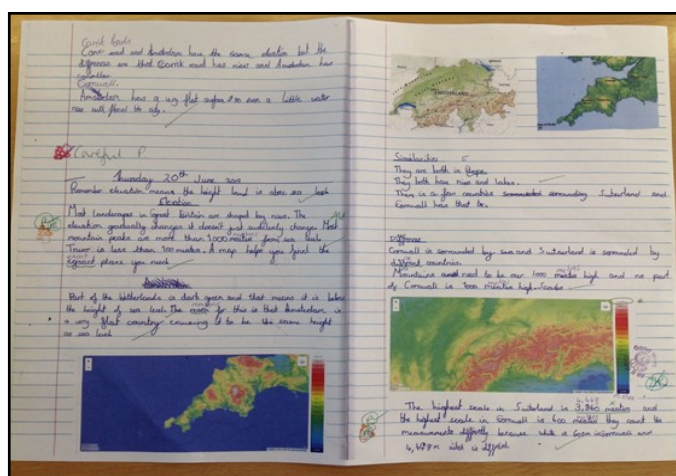
## Year 3 Pollination Homework

Lets make our park a friendlier environment for nature - help us build a bug hotel or make seed bombs.

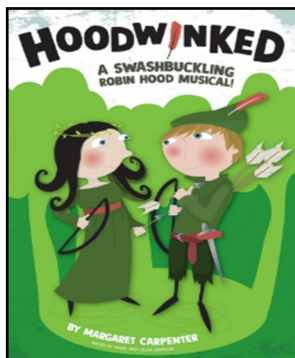
