Viking and Saxon Workshops

On Tuesday and Wednesday this week children in years 3, 4, 5 and 6 took part in Viking and Saxon workshops. Adrian Chapman from Blast from the Past gave a Viking presentation on the battle of Stamford Bridge in 1066 and children did workshops on Viking words, runes and longboats. They also took part in a quiz about where Vikings travelled and played in the Nine Man's Morris game.

In the afternoon the children listened to a presentation on the story of Alfred the Great. A discussion took place about why the story of eating burnt cakes has survived. Children learnt about battle tactics and took part in a battle re-enactment on the school field using Viking shields. Thank you to Kea School Friends for funding the workshops.

Well done girls and good luck for next weekend.


Message from Kea School Friends	New Toy Shop
