Parent Communication

This week you should have received your child's data collection sheet via the school book bag for checking and returning to school. It is really important that you keep us updated with your mobile number, home phone number and email address in case we need to contact you should your child become unwell during the school day.

Last term we introduced a text reminder service for parents and this term we are using their email service. This system pulls across the data we hold for parents from our School Information Management System. Therefore, in order for parents to receive messages via text or email we must hold your correct details.
