

Maths

We will continue to work on identifying and using fractions and consolidating our knowledge of shapes. Following this, we will work on telling the time and time themed maths problems. Finally, we will revise the four operations and prepare for KS1 SATs.

Art and DT

Art will complement our focus on our local area this half term. We will be producing some landscape art based on the amazing views from our balcony. We will learn about perspective. Following this, we will draw maps to depict some of the places we have learned about in Geography.

Literacy

Literacy kicks off this term with a focus on stories about toys by familiar authors such as Shirley Hughes and Mick Inkpen. We will innovate on these stories to create our own lost toy stories. After this, we turn our writing to poetry - focussing on nature poetry, inspired by spring. Finally we will write a non-chronological report about our local area.

Science

As spring arrives, we will turn our scientific exploration to plants and nature. Through exploration of our beautiful school grounds and experimentation, we will observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. We will find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

PSHE

Inspired by our heroes from the past from last half term, we will think about why we are all different, inspirational people. What makes us special? We will also learn about controlling our emotions and dealing with everyday moral and social dilemmas.

Geography
