All of us at Kea School hope that this year the fundraising help many more children and their families to have the support that they need to make their lives a little less challenging.

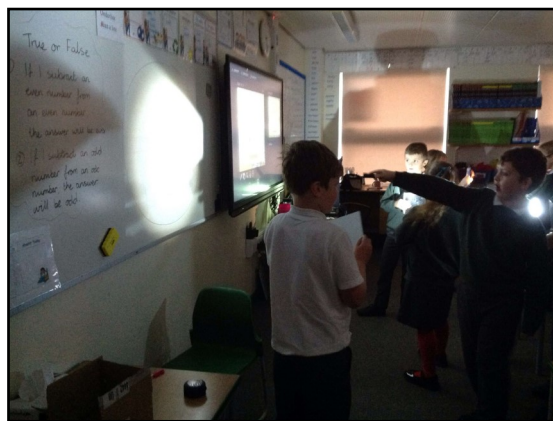
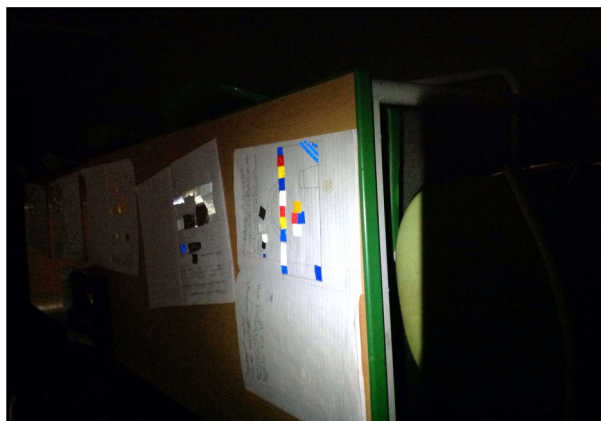

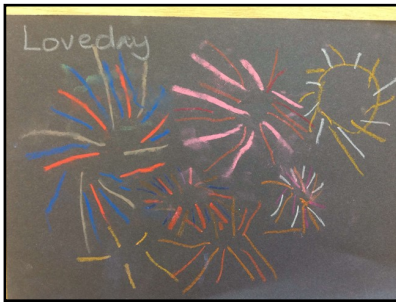
Festivals and Celebrations in Foundation Class

Foundation have started to learn about festivals and celebrations, including Diwali, the Hindu festival of light and bonfire night.

We enjoyed an Indian meal and tasted poppadoms, naan bread, onion bhajis, pilau rice, korma sauce and mango chutney. We talked about the ingredients and enjoyed the smells. We encouraged the children to try it all and they were fantastic. It was a new food for many and lots were going to ask to eat an Indian meal at home! While we ate, we listened to some Indian music. After, we voted for our favourite foods and made a bar chart to show this.

In maths, we have been learning about 2d shapes. We made our own Rangoli patterns using 2d shapes and in art, decorated Rangoli patterns using lentils and rice and pasta. We thought about repeating patterns and made our own choices as to how we would decorate them. We also designed rockets using 2d shapes and drew firework pictures in ICT.

In literacy, we practised lots of different handwriting patterns when we designed our own mehndi hand decorations and also when we drew firework pictures. We also started to write words to describe the sounds that fireworks make, such as 'pop' and 'bang'.

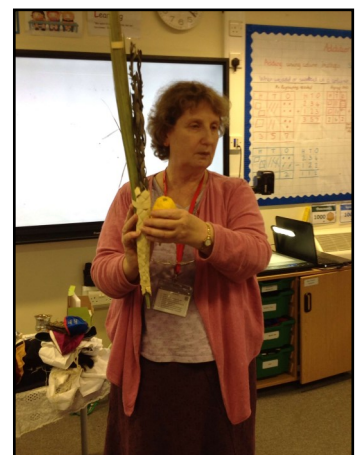


Firework pictures in ICT

Come to school on Friday 13 December wearing a Christmas themed jumper or t-shirt to raise money for Save the Children. We ask for a donation of a £1.



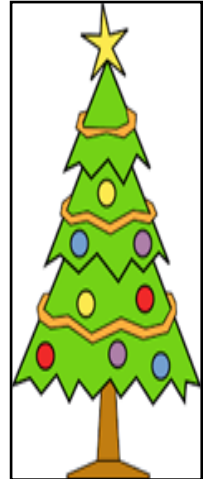
