This term the school will be learning about World War 2. On the 15 April, the teachers planned for the juniors to have an entry point day, where we did four different activities.



In Year 3, we made scones and they are made from potato. This is because during the war they had to ration things like eggs, butter and milk. In Year 4, we sang some songs from World War 2. They were mainly about peace and new life after the war. In Year 5, we made Anderson shelters for when the Germans bombed Britain. We made the shelters out of cardboard and camouflaged them with paint, leaves and tinfoil. In year 6 we learned about Britain at war. They fought in planes called Spitfires, Hurricanes and Torpedoes.
