Supervision After School

When playing in school grounds after school, children need to be closely supervised by parents at all times. This term we have talked to children in classes and reminded them that school rules (expected behaviour, areas of the school which are out of bounds etc.) they're expected to follow at break/lunchtimes also need to be followed after school.

In the past week however, staff who have been leading after school clubs (e.g. football club) have needed to leave their clubs a number of times to deal with incidents including: children waving a 6 foot branch in others' faces, playing behind and scrambling up the very steep bank at the far side of the field (this area is fenced off and children had to jump or clamber over the fence to get there), running around on the pirate ship, throwing sticks at each other and climbing onto a shed roof. On each of these occasions, parents of the particular children involved were not in sight.

In the past couple of years, there have been a number of accidents after school, including some which required 999 emergency services. A high number of these incidents occurred while their parent was in a different part of the school grounds and not directly supervising their children.

I know that children and parents alike appreciate the fact that the school grounds are available to play in after school; however, if children are not adequately supervised we will be left with no option but to close the school site at the end of the day, in line with the policy of most other schools.

School Immunisations for Years 1, 2 & 3

Kernow Health CIC are delivering the new school immunisation service from October onwards.

About the Programme

Children in Years 1, 2 and 3 are due to receive a nasal spray flu vaccination on 3 November 2016. All nurses are experienced practice nurses from local GP surgeries and are all used to delivering vaccines. The children will be vaccinated by age group. A Teaching Assistant from your child's class will take the children, in groups, to our meeting room where they will receive their immunisation. The reason for this way of immunisation is that we have the poorest up-take in flu immunisations, so this is the most efficient way to get the whole population protected.

Consent process

Four weeks before the immunisation date you will receive a letter and consent form which must be completed and returned to the school.
