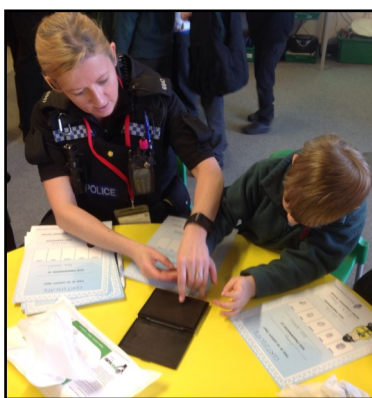




## Year One Police Visit
