Last Friday KS1 launched their 'Transport' topic with a number of exciting workshops. Staff worked hard to prepare

for this day and some of the teachers spent the day in role dressed as Victorian characters. In year 2 a steam train driver spoke to the children via video link, telling the children all about his job. The children then took part in "hot seating" activities, learning more from each other about the train driver's job. The inventor of the Penny Farthing, James Starley, visited the Year I class room and the children learned how the bicycle has changed over time. In the Foundation class room the children learned about Icarus and the first flying machines. The classroom then became a test flight area for paper aeroplanes! The children learned so much about transport and they are eager to discover, in more detail, just how transport has changed through history.
