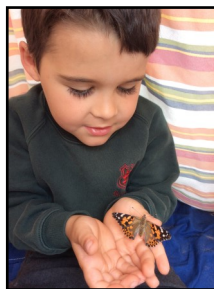
All children showed fantastic resilience and challenged themselves. They were a fantastic team and we are so proud of them. Well done Year 5!
