During the weeks starting the 13th and 20th March, you can audition in your class to be part of the school talent show after giving a 50p donation. Teachers will let you know the date of your class audition. Two acts from each class will then be picked to take part in the main talent show in front of the whole school. You could do any talent so get practising!
