Dear Parents and Carers

Phased return for pupils in YF, 1 and 6

I am writing with a little more information about pupils in YF, 1 and 6 returning to school in June. I will provide further details next week.

Key workers' children in Y2, 3, 4 and 5 will still be welcome to attend school. As ever, I urge that you only send your children to school when you absolutely need to – only on occasions when you are not able to stay at or work from home. This has worked well over the past two months; we have had different children in each day and this has helped manage our group sizes. If numbers increase too much, we will be unable to provide provision for all key workers' children, and may have to prioritise those who have two parents who are both key workers, in the same way as several other schools.

I have almost completed a risk assessment which governors are currently going through in fine detail, cross referencing with latest government guidance. I am in the process of completing a FAQ sheet for parents and Mrs Harvey and Mrs Olive are working on putting returning children into groups.

At this stage, I am still unsure as to whether we will be able to offer wrap around care. If we are able to offer any sessions, it is likely not to be every day and possible that it will only be for key workers' children. Children from YF, 1 and 6 who require wrap around care may have to spend their day in the key workers' group rather than with the rest of their year group. I am in the process of finalising these details.

I am working with staff and governors to confirm details, and will write to you by the middle of next week giving information about groups, classrooms, staffing, start/end times.
