As an exciting start to our Autumn term topic on "Houses and Homes" in KS1 and "Victorians" in KS2, all classes will be visiting Lanhydrock House. We are National Trust members and "Kea School Friends" have very generously offered to pay for our transport, so the trip is absolutely free.

Lanhydrock is the perfect example of a Victorian Country House and the children will be able to experience life through the eyes of the Victorian family, the servants and the children who lived there. To make the experience really authentic we would like the children to dress up in Victorian clothes. This could be a long skirt, blouse and shawl or grey shorts, shirt and cap.

Each class will visit Lanhydrock on a different day in September/October as follows:

Friday 27 September – year 3 & 4 Monday 30 September – year 5 & 6 Monday 7 October – year 1 & 2

For each visit we will leave school at 9.15 am and depart from Lanhydrock at 2.15 pm.

If your child is entitled to a free school meal or you would like to order a packed lunch from the kitchen, please complete the attached form. You are, of course, welcome to provide your own packed lunch for your child if you prefer. Packed lunch order forms must be returned by Monday 16 September. The kitchen will be unable to provide any packed lunches after this date. We would be very grateful if some parents could volunteer to accompany the children; due to limited spaces on the bus you would need to meet us at the gate house at 10.30 am.
