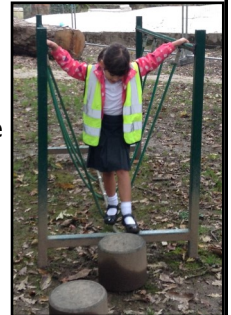




## Year 2 Walk to Playing Play

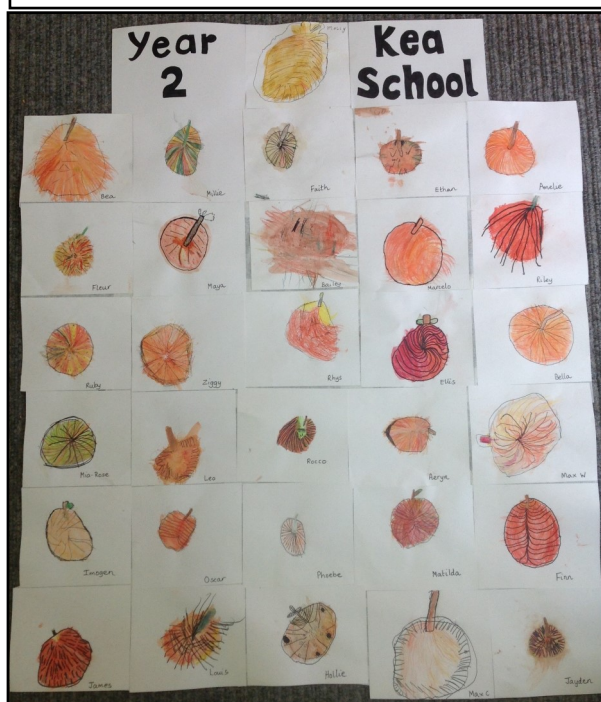


## Transfer to Secondary School September 2018

### Year 2 Visit to Royal Cornwall Museum

On Friday, Year 2 enjoyed participating in a workshop at the Royal Cornwall Museum in Truro, finding out about a local inventor from the past, Richard Trevithick. We were surprised to meet Richard's wife, Jane, who was equally surprised to see our 'peculiar' clothes and to find out that girls, as well as boys, attend school today! Mrs Trevithick told us about her husband's inventions and his travels around the world, including South America. She read us some of his letters and told us about the invention of the steam locomotive. We found out that historical objects are called 'artefacts' and we examined many artefacts which related to Richard Trevithick's life and work. We then each made a clay tile with a raised picture of his steam locomotive on it, carefully adding the date '1804' to show when it was invented. After lunch, Year 2 looked closely at artefacts relating to Cornish local and geological history, and made careful, labelled sketches. "I love it here!" exclaimed Molly. Finally, we explored the interactive exhibits in the Cornish natural history gallery. It was a very busy day of learning!
