Year 6 Hit the Surf - Tuesday 19 September 2017

On Tuesday this week, Year 6 got their wetsuits on and Hit The Surf! They travelled to Newquay's beautiful Fistral Beach to meet with the RNLI trainers and lifeguards. We were given a safety talk and introduced to the life saving procedures before taking to the water and hitting those waves. The children had a fantastic time, and as you would expect the behaviour from Kea children was impeccable. Everyone took part and put in tremendous effort, on the coach on the way back we even had a few snoozing from the exhaustion! A fantastic trip all round.







Supervision After School

When playing in school grounds after school, children need to be closely supervised by parents at all times. We will be talking to children in classes and remind them that school rules (expected behaviour, areas of the school which are out of bounds etc.) they're expected to follow at break/lunchtimes also need to be followed after school.

In the past couple of years, there have been a number of accidents after school, including some which required 999 emergency services. A high number of these incidents occurred while their parent was in a different part of the school grounds and not directly supervising their children.

This issue has been raised in the past and for some time the situation improved considerably. In the past week however, staff who have been leading after school clubs (e.g. football club) have needed to leave their clubs a number of times to deal with incidents including: children playing on bikes and skateboards (with no helmets or protective equipment), children playing unsupervised on the adventure playground (some trying to climb over or sit on the top of the climbing wall), children trying to jump over the side of the pirate ship onto the playground (over 2m drop) and waving sticks in people's faces.

Children should not be playing on bicycles or skateboards in the school grounds or carpark. I know that children and parents alike appreciate the fact that the school grounds are available to play in after school; however, if children are not adequately supervised we will be left with no option but to close the school site at the end of the day, in line with the policy of most other schools.

Transfer to Secondary School September 2018


