Pupil Acceptable Use Agreement

As part of our Online Safety policy, which has recently been reviewed and approved by governors, we are required to ask pupils to read, sign and return to school the attached Pupil Acceptable Use Agreement.

The agreements have been tailored age appropriate as follows:

- Pupil Acceptable Use Agreement for Year 5 & 6 children. Parent/carer to go through agreement with their child and both parent/carer and child to sign.
- Pupil Acceptable Use Agreement for Year 3 & 4 children. Parent/carer to go through agreement with their child and both parent/carer and child to sign.
- Pupil Acceptable Use Agreement for Year F, 1 & 2 children. Parent/carer to go through agreement with their child and sign on behalf of their child.
