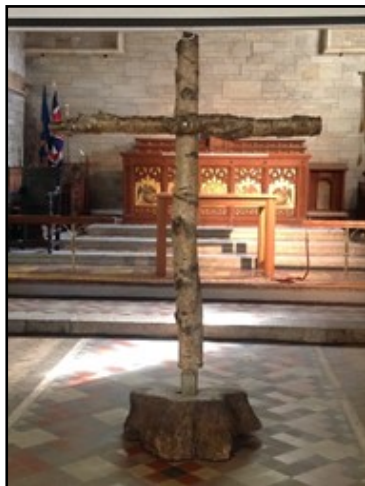




Year 1 and 2 Kea Church Visit

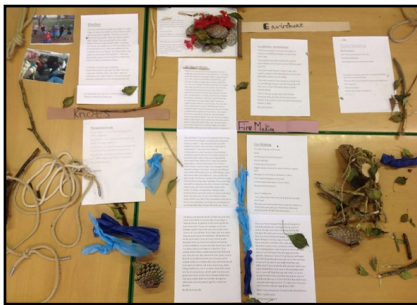
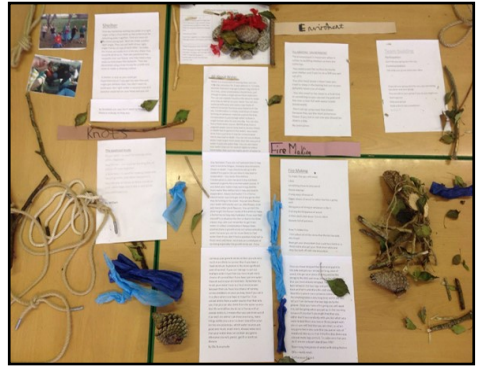


Year 5 Marble Treat



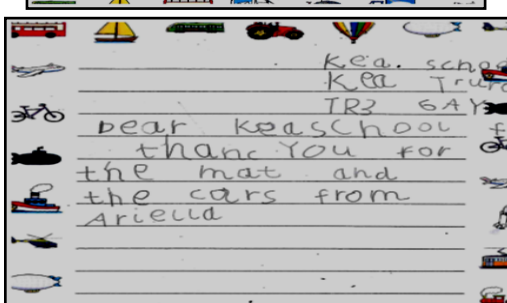
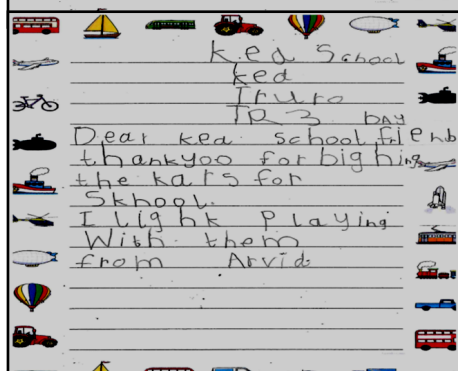
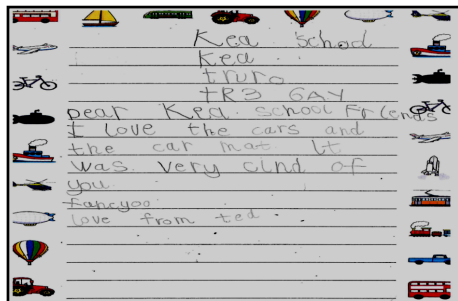

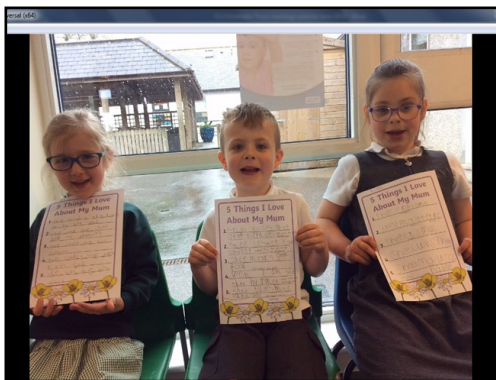
Irish Dancing Success
