## Year 4 BF Adventure - 6 & 7 May 2020

I am delighted to inform you that we have arranged a 2 day, 1 night residential for Year 4 pupils at the BF Activity Centre, between Penryn and Helston, next May. BF is an excellent centre for outdoor pursuits. For more information about the centre please visit their website - <a href="https://www.bfadventure.org">www.bfadventure.org</a>.

The children will travel from school by coach and will arrive at camp by 10.00 am, in time for morning activities on the Wednesday. We will stay overnight in cabins, take part in activities the following day and arrive back at school on Thursday afternoon. Children will need a packed lunch on the first day.

All the activities are organised and supervised by fully trained activity leaders. The children will take part in several different activities which could include climbing and abseiling, archery and problem solving. Meals will be provided by BF.

The cost of the visit, including transport to and from the centre, food, accommodation and all activities offers good value at a cost of £120.00 per child. We ask for a deposit of £40.00 by Friday 20 September 2019. You can pay the balance in instalments or in full by Friday 20 March 2020. All payments will need to be paid using your online Parent Pay Account. A kit list is also attached.

We are hoping that every child in the class will be able to take part in the camp. Please contact me if funding the visit is a problem or your child has any special requirements. The school will try to help. Any pupils not taking part will join other junior classes for the two days.

If any parent/carer would be interesting in organising a fund raising event to reduce the cost of the trip for all children, please let the school know.

## YEAR 4 BF Aventure CAMP 2020 - KIT LIST

- Please ensure that all items are marked with your child's name it can prove impossible to reunite children with lost kit if the kit is not clearly named.
- ❖ Due to unpredictable nature of Cornish weather the clothing and footwear items on this list are to be packed and are to be additional to the clothes the children will wear to travel to camp.
- Cameras are not required as staff will take photographs and share them with the children when they are back at school. However, some children may bring a disposable camera.
- Personal radios, stereos, electronic games and mobile phones are not permitted.
- ❖ If you are unable to provide any of the items please let the class teachers know in advance of the camp.
- 1. Sleeping bag (packed separately)
- 2. Towel and wash bag containing soap, flannel, toothbrush, and toothpaste.
- 3. Torch (and spare battery)
- 4. A pillow in a pillow case.
- 5. Trousers for outdoor activities that allow ease of movement.
- 6. Pyjamas (although from experience it can be better to sleep in a tracksuit providing more warmth)
- 7. Two changes of underwear.
- 8. A large towel.
- A minimum of two changes of clothes including t-shirts, trousers, jumpers/fleeces
- 10. Warm socks x 3
- 11. Waterproof jacket and trousers. If you happen to have 2 coats, put them in just incase one gets very wet. This is not essential though.
- 12. Wellies, walking boots (if you have them) and a second pair of trainers
- 13. Shoes to go in water (wetsuit boots or trainers)
- 14. Swimming shorts and t-shirt or rash vest over swimming costume

- 15. A sun hat or cap
- 16. Unbreakable drinks container filled with water (500ml plus)
- 17. Two binliners for wet and dirty clothes
- 18. A packed lunch in a box for the first day
- 19. Suncream (minimum factor 25, and lip balm if required)
- 20. A large sturdy day pack to contain: full waterproofs, suncream, sunhat, packed lunch and a drink (for the first day)
- 21. A book to read.
- 22. A cuddly toy.
