Governor observation and comments

- Visits were made to all classrooms
- -It is pleasing to report that there has been considerable overall improvement in the quality and nature of displays throughout the school (including circulation areas)
- -These are set in the context of much tidier classrooms taking into consideration that they are practical working environments
- -All classrooms are now bright, colourful and stimulating learning environments and feature work and information representing different subjects of the curriculum
- -A good feature in many of the displays is the use of photographs, many taken by the children themselves, and serve to highlight well, 'work in progress'
- -Many displays are interactive and help to promote the pupils' learning. In most instances, but not all, questions posed by teachers also feature pupils' responses
- -An area for development that the school might wish to consider is the provision of space for the older pupils in particular to organise and present their own displays.
