## Gymnastics Success



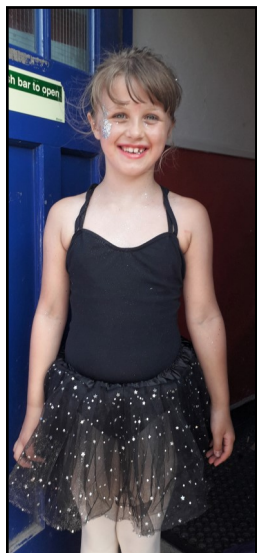
