Year 5 Penair Art Project

From 30th October to 11th December, year five did an art project on a famous graffiti artist from Brazil, who is named 'L7M'. Luckily, a professional art teacher from Penair, Mr Brett, came in to teach us about this graffiti artist and how to imitate his work.

We looked at different techniques, which were: tracing numerous choices of images of birds onto our A3 sheet of paper (pressure transfer); creating spots and bold sweeps across the page- although it proved to be quite nerve-wracking for us since we didn't want to ruin our work, therefore Mr Brett encouraged us to 'not be afraid'; shading; embellishing a piece; taking a line for a walk and adding doodles and sketching whilst using a compass.





The following week, our Penair art teacher (Mr Brett) took us on a trip to Penair School, where he showed us how to use filters (such as neon glow) on Photoshop as well as: cropping; changing the colours; adjusting brightness to our liking and playing around with the scale.

The completed paintings were truly exceptional pieces which showed high quality, expectations and attention to detail.
