- Count in 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Count in 3s

Addition and Subtraction

We will be learning to:

- Know addition and subtraction number bonds to 20.
- Number bonds (in 10s) to 100
- Add/ subtract 1s
- Add/ subtract two 2-digit numbers (crossing ten)
- Number bonds to 100 (tens and ones)
- Add three 1-digit numbers)

Literacy

We will be learning how to:

- Recall, write and reinvent traditional myths and legends of Cornwall such as The Mousehole Cat, The Mermaid of Zennor and Cormoran the Giant.
- Write acrostic poems about different Cornish Myths and Legend characters including Cornish Piskies.

Grammar focus:

Humanities


We will be learning how to:
