Can you design a new symbol for recycling?

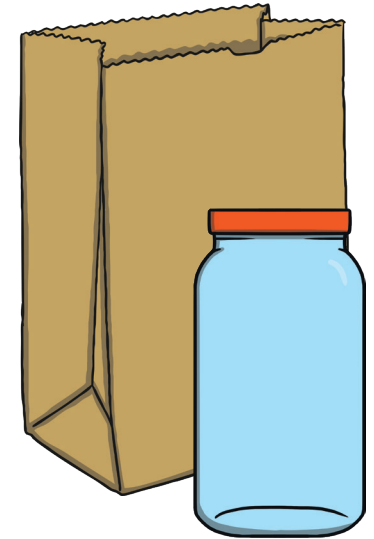

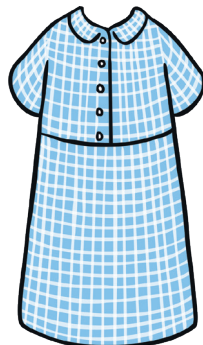
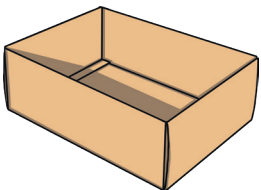

Look round a car boot sale for something that could be used for another purpose. You might find something that would make an unusual flowerpot or a unique clothes hook or pencil pot.



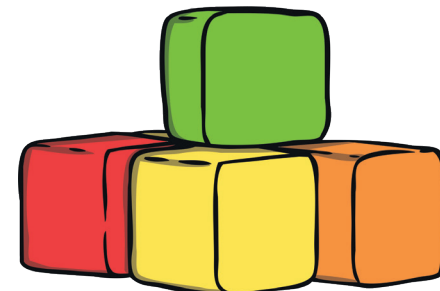

Choose a type of recycling to take to a local recycling centre and ask your neighbours or even the whole street if they have anything to add to your collection.



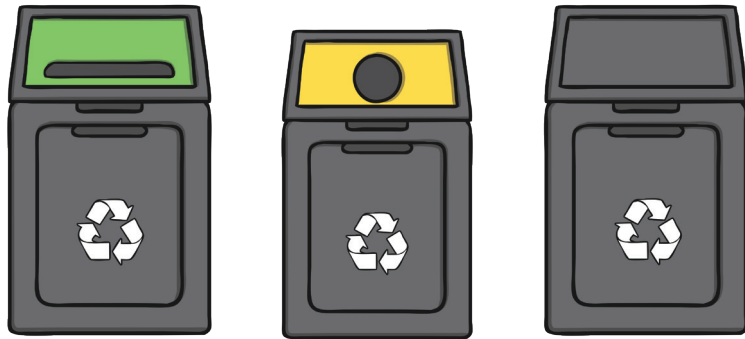
Start a compost bin at home to make good use of organic waste.



Complete a recycling symbol scavenger hunt.

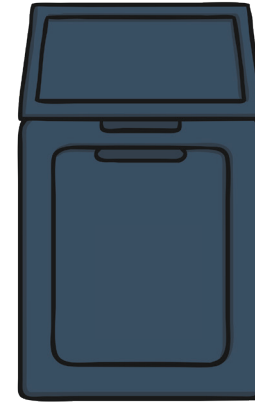


Take a trip to your local recycling centre and see how many more items can be recycled there.



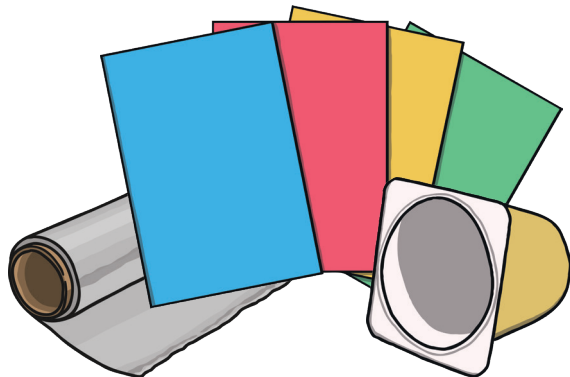
