Dear Parents and Carers

Re: Relationships and Sex Education

After half term I will be teaching Year 6 their Relationships and Sex education unit as part of their Personal, Social, Health and Economic education. We are notifying you so you are aware of the content before we teach it and to give context to any conversations that may arise as a result of these lessons.

We are following a Scheme of work called Walk Tall Growing Up B. The children who were at Kea in Year 4 completed Growing Up A. The first session will recap this, Year 5 units and bridge any gaps for children who did not complete them.

The scheme encourages conversation based around the science of our reproductive system and the emotional feelings and responsibilities that happen around puberty.

The Year 6 unit includes the following topics:

- Life changes
- Hygiene and our basic needs
- Changes of puberty
- Identifying parts of male and female reproductive system
- Feelings associated with growing up
- Appropriate and inappropriate touch

These lessons will take place on Wednesday afternoons for this half term and Mrs Tucker will be present in the classroom so there is continuity and a 'go to' adult should the children wish to speak about anything on a day when I am not in school.
