Please find below a comprehensive guide to all known dragon eggs.

Included is an illustration of the egg and a short description about what type of dragon will hatch from it, including the name of the dragon, where it lives and what it does.

| Dragon Egg | Type of dragon |

|  | <p>River Dragon: The river dragon lives under riverbanks and can fly but prefers to stay close to the water at all times. Having gills like a fish, enables it to breathe below water and it will often leave its eggs in a dark, damp place to hatch.</p> |
|  | <p>Siberian Drakon: <i>Please note this breed of dragon is deadly from birth mainly due to its ability to freeze anything to a temperature of -60.</i> Living in the far reaches of Siberia, in caves and underground caverns, the Siberian Drakon has, so far, not strayed any further than Moscow. To its victim it delivers an icy stare, which at first paralyses and then turns them into ice. Please use anti-freeze glasses when approaching this dragon!</p> |
